# SAT & ACT Prep Classes



## **ACT Classroom Course**

Princeton Review is one of the leaders in college preparatory. The Princeton Review ACT classroom course retails at \$599, but have partnered with Marriotts Ridge Student Services and the PTSA to offer you the course at \$399 with the portion of the proceeds going to support MRHS activities. The ACT course includes 18 hours of classroom instruction with 16 hours of testing for a total of 34 hours of preparation. The ACT course meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:00pm – 8:00pm and classes will run from Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday April 5<sup>th</sup>. ## **The Princeton Review Assessment**

Not sure whether to take the SAT or the ACT? The Princeton Review Assessment (PRA), an ACT/SAT combination test, is designed to help you determine which test is best suited for your abilities. This event also allows you the unique opportunity to take a practice exam under actual testing conditions. Knowing your results early will give you time to improve your game before test day. The PRA will be offered at Marriotts Ridge High School on Saturday, February 5, 2010 from 8am – 12pm (snow date Saturday February 12<sup>th</sup>).

After the PRA exam, attend the Scores Back Session on Thursday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> at 7pm. At the session, practice tests will be passed back and a detailed review of the scores will be provided. The cost for both the practice test and Scores Back session is \$10. Class size is limited to 120, but attendance is open to all Howard County High School students, so register early to get a spot. ## **SAT Prep Class**
