

HIGH SCHOOL SEMESTER EXAMINATION WEEK JANUARY 2008

Monday, January 14, 2008	Full day – Period 1 Exam followed by revised Bell Schedule (See attached Schedule #1). No extra curricular activities including practices, rehearsals, events, etc.
Tuesday, January 15, 2008	Day 2 - Examinations – Periods 2 & 3 (See attached Schedule #2) Schools close 3 hours early. No extra curricular activities except conditioning practices (1 1/2 hours) which may begin at 2:45 p.m.
Wednesday, January 16, 2008	Day 3 - Examinations – Periods 4A & 4B (See attached Schedule #2) Schools close 3 hours early. No extra curricular activities except conditioning practices (1 1/2 hours) which may begin at 2:45 p.m.
Thursday, January 17, 2008	Day 4 - Examinations – Periods 5 & 6 (See attached Schedule #2) Schools close 3 hours early. All extra curricular activities resume at 2:45pm
Friday, January 18, 2008	No School for Students

Inclement weather

1. If there is a delayed opening on Monday, January 14, the attached Schedule #3 would be used.
2. If schools are CLOSED on Monday, January 14, period 1 & 2 exams will be given on Tuesday, January 15, period 3 & 4A exams on Wednesday, January 16, period 4B & 5 exams on Thursday January 17 (see attached Schedule #4). Period 6 exam on Tuesday, January 22 will be given in the period 5 & 6 time slots on the normal time schedule.
3. If there is a delayed opening on any examination day, it will be a two-hour delay. School will open at 9:25 a.m. and close at 2:10 p.m. The appropriate exams will be given using attached Schedule #4.
4. If there is a snow day on any examination day, the exams scheduled for that day will be given on the next school day.
5. All extra curricular activities will resume on Thursday, January 17, regardless of late opening or snow days.
